ORDER

1. In supersession of this office order no. 4729-4826 dated 17.05.2021, the following 55 treatment procedures are exclusively reserved for treatment under Ayushman Bharat - Mukh Mantri Sehat Bima Yojana (AB-MMSBY) in all Govt. hospitals of Punjab:
 - i. Appendix surgeries (2 procedures)
 - ii. Gallbladder surgeries (4 procedures)
 - iii. Fissure/Fistula/Piles surgeries (4 procedures)
 - iv. Hernia surgeries (10 procedures)
 - v. Orthopedic fractures/ surgeries (34 procedures)
 - vi. Glaucoma surgery of eye (1 procedure)

The detailed list of procedures of the above-mentioned surgical procedures, along with their respective rates and procedure codes, is enclosed at Annexure-A and is also available on the website: <https://www.sha.punjab.gov.in/>.

2. 8 (eight) medical management procedures in addition to above procedures have been additionally exclusively reserved for treatment only in Public hospitals. The detailed list of these 8 procedures is enclosed at Annexure-B and is also available on the website: <https://www.sha.punjab.gov.in/>.
3. The reservation of the above procedures in Public hospitals will come into effect from the date of implementation of the reservation of the treatment procedures in the TMS portal by the National Health Authority (NHA), Govt. of India.
4. Further, Normal Delivery is excluded from the Health Benefit Package list under AB-MMSBY from the succeeding day of issuance of these orders.
